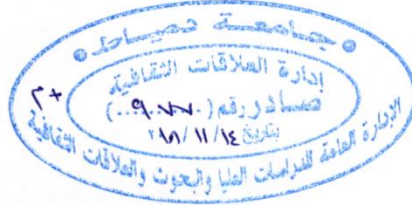

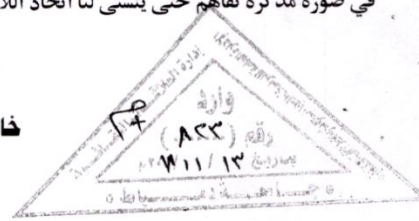

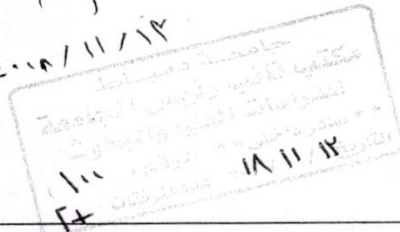

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
(Hereinafter referred to as "the MoU"),

Between

(Hereinafter referred to as "the _____ ")

And

GUJARAT FORENSIC SCIENCES UNIVERSITY- INDIA
(Hereinafter referred to as "GFSU") .

CONCERNING THE STRATEGIC ACADEMIC , TRAINING & RESEARCH CO-OPERATION IN VARIOUS AREAS OF FORENSIC SCIENCES

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS the _____ and GFSU (hereinafter jointly referred to as "the Parties" and individually as "the Party") wish to enter into this MoU for the purposes of establishing strategic academic and training co-operation in Forensic & Investigative sciences.

WHEREAS _____

WHEREAS GFSU is a highly specialised higher education institution established under the laws of Gujarat-India that provides, education, training and consultancy in specialised areas including, but not limited to Forensic Sciences , Cyber Security , Forensic Accounting and Financial Fraud Investigation, Forensic Odontology, Forensic Psychology and state of the art technology / Forensic laboratories for Investigation, Education and Training purposes;

NOW THEREFORE the Parties hereby agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1

SCOPE AND FIELDS OF STRATEGIC CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 The Parties hereby agree to implement within the framework of the rules and regulations applicable to each of the Parties and subject to availability of funds and resources, the following programmes and activities which may include, but are not limited to:
 - 1.1.1 Assistance by GFSU in setting up different laboratories, for example, Cyber Security Laboratory, Digital Forensic Laboratory, Forensic Sciences Laboratory etc. and upgrading existing Laboratories for _____ in Egypt ;

- 1.1.2. Designing of short term certificate training programs for students in different areas as agreed mutually by _____ & GFSU.
 - 1.1.3 GFSU will provide assistance in designing of Forensic Sciences Lab preparation of SOP , preparation of Organization structure , providing proficiency test and certification after skill test to _____ in Egypt .
 - 1.1.4 GFSU and _____ will work on different Forensic research areas on mutually agreed terms with _____ for students and faculty.
 - 1.1.5 GFSU & _____ will exchange their students and faculty on agreed terms.
 - 1.1.6 GFSU will provide information to _____ on ICCR scholarship scheme from Government of India for free education at GFSU campus at Master or PG level for different specializations.
 - 1.1.7 GFSU & _____ work mutually on 1+1 Master level program or 6 Month PG level program in agreed disciplines.
- 1.2 The Parties agree that the terms and conditions of any agreed programme or activity contemplated in this MoU shall be the subject matter of separate written agreements to be negotiated and agreed upon by the Parties and/or any other parties, wherever applicable. **Provided always that** the decision whether to initiate and/or implement any programme or activity shall be at the sole discretion of each Party.
- 1.3 The Parties agree to designate a co-ordinator whose responsibility shall be to supervise the execution of this MoU and to draw up programmes or activities to be implemented under this MoU.

ARTICLE 2

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

The specific financial arrangements for academic programmes, training programmes and any other related programmes and services shall be discussed and decided by mutual consent as and when required by the Parties to this MoU.

ARTICLE 3
INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 3.1 The Parties agree that any intellectual property rights arising from or in connection with any programme or activity under this MoU, through and by the joint and collaborative efforts of the Parties shall be jointly owned and subject to any other terms and conditions as may be agreed upon in writing.
- 3.2 The Parties shall acknowledge one another in any form of writing, publication or presentation based on research derived from the co-operative efforts of the Parties under this MoU, unless otherwise mutually agreed upon in writing.

ARTICLE 4
CONFIDENTIALITY

The Parties agree and undertake to keep confidential at all times any information or data that may be exchanged, acquired or shared in connection with any programme or activity conducted pursuant to this MoU save where the same is already in public the domain.

ARTICLE 5
ENTRY INTO FORCE AND DURATION

This MoU shall enter into force on the date of the last signature and shall be valid for period of three (3) years from the date of signature by the Parties and may be extended for such further periods as may be agreed by the Parties in writing.

ARTICLE 6
TERMINATION

- 6.1 This MoU may be terminated at any time by mutual agreement between the Parties or by any Party giving the other written notice of not less than three (3) months of its intention to terminate this MoU.
- 6.2 At the termination of this MoU, the provisions of any other separate agreement entered into pursuant to this MoU shall continue to govern any unexpired obligations commenced or assumed hereunder until they are fully executed.

ARTICLE 7 MISCELLANEOUS

The Parties acknowledge that all visits or exchange of staff, students or administrative shall be subject to compliance with the entry and visa regulations of the Parties respective countries.

ARTICLE 8 NON-BINDING NATURE OF THE MoU

- 8.1 This MoU is not intended to be legally binding. It merely expresses the intent and understanding of the Parties which shall form the basis of any legally binding agreement(s) to be drafted and executed in the future.
- 8.2 The Parties hereby agree that they are not bound exclusively by this MoU and shall be at liberty to enter into any separate agreements or arrangements with any third party without reference to the other Party.

ARTICLE 9 FORCE MAJEURE

- 9.1 In the event of the occurrence of an event of *force majeure* which shall include but not be limited to the following; riots, floods, acts of God, natural disasters and wars, neither Party shall be held accountable for the problems and costs arising from the failure to fulfil obligations under this MoU.
- 9.2 In the event that the *force majeure* subsists for a period of six (6) months, the Party experiencing such event shall give fourteen (14) days written notice to the other Party, where upon this MoU shall automatically terminate due to supervening impossibility of performance.

ARTICLE 10 APPLICABLE LAW

The MoU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the India

ARTICLE 11 DISPUTE(S) RESOLUTION

The Parties seek to resolve amicably in good faith any dispute(s) that may arise in respect of any matter connected to this MoU.

ARTICLE 12

DOMICILIUM CITANDI ET EXECUTANDI

12.1 Every notice, request or any other communication required or permitted to be given pursuant to this MoU shall be in writing, in the English language, and delivered personally or sent by registered or certified post via air mail or by courier or e-mail or facsimile (which shall be acknowledged by the other Party) to the other Party at the address and facsimile number as stated below:


